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S U M M A R Y

This past weekend we looked at the way that Future Glory begins now. What you are going through now is the beginning of new creation.

R E A D

Colossians 1:15-23 | 2 Corinthians 5:17-20

Pause. Take time to prayerfully consider what has been read.

D I S C U S S

- 1) Describe the ways that Jesus has already been working reconciliation in your life
- 2) What area of your life is Jesus wanting to more fully reconcile to Himself?
- 3) Ask Jesus: In what ways are you calling me to be a person who offers your reconciliation to the world?
- 4) Read John 7:37-39 and Revelation 21:1-6. Discuss the things that you are looking forward to in the future new creation, and the things in the new creation that you are celebrating that are available to you right now.

R E S P O N D

Confess to one another the ways in which you know you are not living into the fullness of 'new creation' that Jesus is offering to you.

Invite Jesus to meet you in the places of pain in your life where you long for the fullness of the new creation life Christ offers

P R A Y

Use Psalm 30 as a template for your prayer this week. This psalm offers space for weeping over the hard things, crying out for help, and praising God for the good things. Let Scripture guide you into the deeper intimacy with God that is a part of the New Creation.
