S U M M A R Y

R E A D

Romans 6:1-14

Pause. Take time to prayerfully consider what has been read.

D I S C U S S

Reflect on the stories we heard on Sunday.

- 1) What stood out to you in the testimonies?
- 2) What did you learn or what were you reminded of about Jesus and his good news?

The act of baptism itself tells a story too.

- 3) What is the story being told through baptism and what are the implications of that story in your life?
- 4) What does the passage from Romans teach us about baptism?

R E S P O N D

If you've been baptized, take some time to reflect on your baptism and walk back through your story that led up to that moment. What insight do you sense Jesus asking you to pay attention to?

If you haven't been baptized, take some time to reflect on your story and consider if baptism might be a next step toward fullness in Jesus. What do you sense Jesus saying to you about baptism?

Pray for those that were baptized - that they would be strengthened by the Holy Spirit in the days ahead.

Pray that we would open our hearts to the story of being baptized into Jesus and respond courageously to His invitations in our lives.
