## R E A D

2 Kings 6:8-23 | Revelation 12:11

*Pause. Take time to prayerfully consider what has been read.*

## D I S C U S S

Reflect on the story of Elisha and the servant and what it meant for them to see their situation with spiritual eyes.

- 1) What is the difference between our natural way of seeing and God's way of seeing things?
- 2) What's an experience you have had where a shift in perspective changed the way you moved forward?

Reflect on Revelation 12:11

- 3) How does storytelling (the word of our testimony) push back darkness?
- 4) What has been a time that things have changed in your life because the truth has finally come out about something?
- 5) What resistance or objections do you have to telling your story? Why?

## R E S P O N D

Reflect on the question asked on Sunday and share with a friend or in a group.

*"What story in my life do I need Jesus to give me His vision for?"*

- Ask Jesus, to open your eyes so you can see with spiritual sight.
- Take a look at your story again.
- What new word or insight do you think Jesus wants you to pay attention to?
