SUMMARY

This past weekend we looked at a central passage in the Gospel of Luke that reveals the mission of Jesus and his heart for all people. In the coming weeks we'll be working through parts of the story line-by-line and listening for what Jesus wants us to respond to.

READ

Luke 4: 14-30

Pause. Take time to prayerfully consider what has been read,

DISCUSS

Take time to read through the text a couple of times and familiarize yourself with what is happening in the story.

- 1) What stood out to you as something to pay attention to?
- 2) What questions do you have about the story that are unanswered?
- 3) What's the meaning behind this story and how do you think it applies to your life and this community?
- 4) Where do you see the theme of "No More Outsiders" in this story?

RESPOND

Take some time each day to meditate on the passage and continue to listen for what the Spirit is promoting you to pay attention to.

Keep your eyes open for how the theme of "No More Outsiders" is showing up in your life.

Share how the Spirit is inviting you to respond today and the week to come – to **be with** Jesus, to **become like** Jesus, or to **do what** Jesus does.

PRAY

Invite the Spirit to give us a Christ-centered worldview and His eyes to truly see people like He does.

Take time to wait and pray together. What is Jesus praying for? Come into agreement with His prayers.
